Presentation about equality between boys and girls. Equal behaviour against students with different social backgrounds.

- Our students are at the age of six and ten (between the first and the fourth years) in a primary school.
- Their life is acting on three stages:
 - 1. In family circl



2. In residence surrounding



3. and in their shcool



The effects of these three stages provide their developing and chances in their further life.

Examined fields:

- Children's roles and tasks in the family. Their taking parts in the daily family routin.
- Children's connections with the residental community. (culture, shops, habits, traditions, social events, family activities)
- How do our students approach to the school? (satisfied, dissatisfied, expectations)

Some facts about differences of social background:

- I. Those children who come from a family where parents are permanent unemployed, alcoholic or children are brought up by one parent, live under difficulties, their chances are decreasing
- 2. These children are low cooperativeness, low self-control, low capacity to stay focused on tasks or moody temperament.
- 3. These families are not able to cooperate suitable with the school.

- 4. It there are not expectations, rules, requirements against the children in a family, their development is suffered disadvantages, even if the children have good background and abilities, skills.
- 5. Chances of children who are not able to cooperate with the community, are decreasing.
- 6. Those children have the biggest chances in live, who know what expectations are against them in the family and know their role in the family.

Examination about probabilities of boys and girls. (survey was made about 30 boys and 27 girls)

Basically, there are not big differences between chances of boys and girls. The traditional roles of male and female are inherited through generations.

- This survey was useful in more aspects.
- During analysis, several, new viewpoints were found out to help our educative work.
- The general estimation about class communities gave new ideas how to arrange our work on.
